- Pojdite peš okoli Bohinjskega jezera ali pa si pot skrajšajte z vožnjo z ladjo.
- Povzpnite se na Blejski grad, sprehodite se ob Blejskem jezeru, privoščite si kosilo v starem delu Radovljice.
- Obiščite naravno znamenitost Tolminske korita, sprehodite se do slapu Kozjak.
- Fotografirajte Martuljkovo gorsko skupino, povzpnite se do Martuljskih slapov.
- Raziščite Muzej 1. svetovne vojne v Kobaridu, obiščite Tonovcov grad.
- Walk around Lake Bohinj or shorten your walk by a boat ride.
- Climb to Bled Castle, walk around Lake Bled, have lunch in Radovljica's old town.
- Visit the troughs of the Tolmin Gorges, walk to the Kozjak waterfall.
- Take a photo of the Martuljek mountain group, and climb up to the Martuljek falls.
- Explore the World War I Museum in Kobarid and pay a visit to the antique settlement Tonovcov grad.

CEL DAN FULL DAY

- Obiščite dolino Trente, kjer štirje letni časi tečejo počasi.
- Spočijte se ob Bohinjskem jezeru, sprehodite se do slapu Savica in ob koritih Mostnice, s kabinsko žičnico se povzpnete na Vogel.
- Po starih poteh se povzpnete na razgledni Vršič.
- Sledite poti starih gorskih vodnikov po dolini Vrata od Slovenskega planinskega muzeja po poti Triglavske Bistrice do Aljaževega doma.
- Povzpnete se na razgledni Krn.
- Pay a visit to the Trenta valley, where the seasons seem to change slowly.
- Take a short rest and relax by Lake Bohinj, walk to the Savica waterfall and hike along the Mostnica gorge, or take a ride to Vogel by cable car.
- Hike along the old paths up to the panoramic Vršič pass.
- Retrace the steps of the first mountain guides from the Slovenian Alpine Museum along the Triglavsko Bistrica Trail to the Vrata valley.
- Climb the panoramic summit of Krn.

- Explore the remains of the Isonzo front (Walk of Peace), starting from Log pod Mangartom.
- Make a circular tour of the Julian Alps by bike and train.
- Climb to Stol, the highest peak of Karavanke range, and then continue to the panoramic Golica.

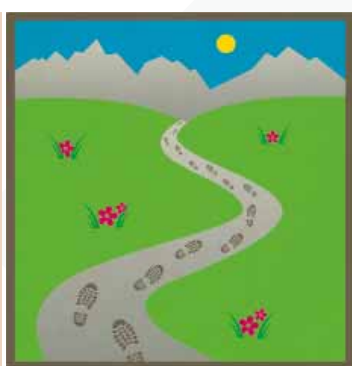

Harsh climate, young and shallow soil, and crumbly limestone rocks foster the growth of Alpine flora. The sturdy vegetation along mountain and other trails is adapted to the demanding conditions of this high-altitude terrain. Attentive visitors who appreciate and respect the sensitive and fragile mountain environment observe the nature conservation, management, and aesthetic guidelines of mountain visitation and refrain from walking outside designated paths.

PARKOVNE POTI TRIGLAVSKEGA NARODNEGA PARKA TRIGLAV NATIONAL PARK TRAILS

Veličastni vrhovi Triglavskega narodnega parka so paša za oči in izziv za hribolazce. Povezujejo jih globoke doline, bogate z gozdovi in kristalno čisto vodo. Bogastvo voda na območju parka je izjemno. Skoraj vsaka izmed dolin ima svojo bistrico, ki že od nekdaj predstavlja osrednje gonilo življenja in razvoja alpskih vasic. Številne izmed teh dolin so danes priljubljene izletniške točke, saj so reke ustvarile čudovite površinske hidrogeomorfološke oblike, ki privabljajo lepote in (v polni vročini) hladu željne obiskovalce. Parkovne poti na različnih delih narodnega parka so namenjene spoznavanju posebnosti teh dolin. Raznovrstne v dolžini in zahtevnosti imajo skupno lastnost – poleg veličastnih razgledov pozornemu obiskovalcu ponujajo drobna čudeša narave. Da jih boste doživeli, se v globoke gozdove in prijeten hlad alpskih rečic podajte peš.

Parkovne poti so načeloma nezahtevne (lahke) pohodniške poti. Bodite pozorni na njihovo dolžino, saj nekatere lahko prehodite v eni uri, za druge pa boste potrebovali cel dan.



The magnificent summits of Triglav National Park are a feast for the eyes and a challenge for mountaineers. They are separated by valleys rich in forests and crystal-clear waters. The park abounds in water sources. Nearly every valley has a stream, or a river, which is and has always been the lifeline and pulse of Alpine villages. Today these valleys are popular with tourists who are drawn here by the diversity of the rivers' hydrological and geomorphological forms and the promise of beautiful and pleasantly cool environment (in summer). Park trails in various parts of the national park are designed to inform visitors about specific features of these valleys. Although varying in length and difficulty, all trails have one thing in common: besides magnificent views, they show an attentive visitor nature's many tiny miracles. If you wish to see and experience them, set off into deep forests and pleasantly cool shade of Alpine rivers on foot.

Park trails are generally of easy to moderate difficulty. When choosing your trail, consider the duration as the hike may take from one hour to a whole day.

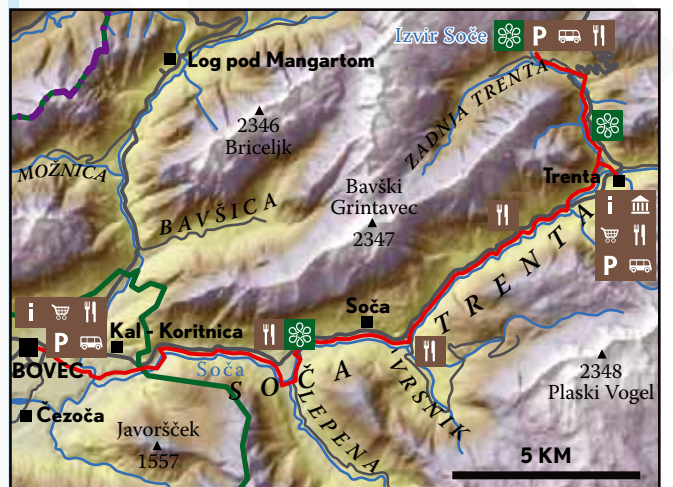

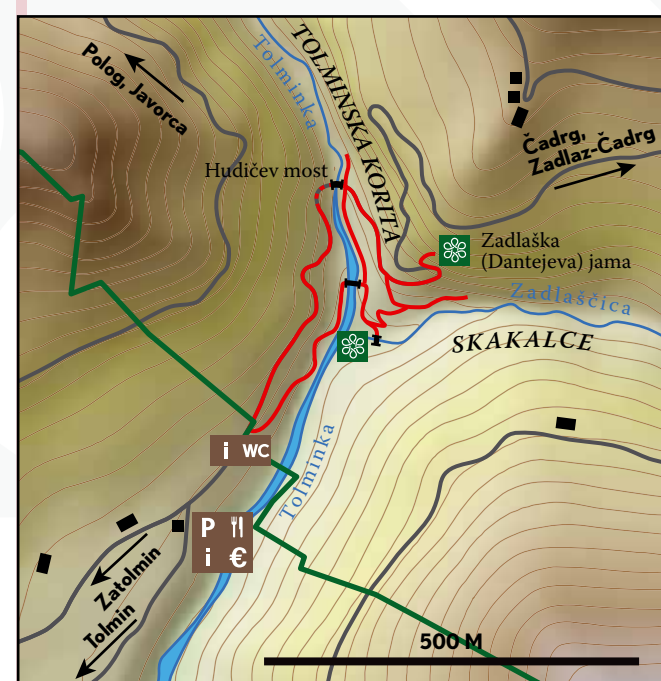

Slovenija, od kod lepote tvoje?

Slovenia, whence thy beauty?

Slovenija je dežela gozdov. Več kot polovica površine je gozdnate. V dobršem delu gozdov smo se izognili gospodarjenju na način velikih posek, zato imamo veliko prstoživečih gozdnih živali. Kmetijska krajina Slovenije je intenzivno obdelana. Pa vendar ne povsod, tako da nas spomladi marsikje očarajo travniki s široko paleto pisanih cvetic, med katerimi do prve košnje brenčijo in poskakujejo številne žuželke. Več kot polovica Slovenije je na kraški podlagi, kjer je bilo do sedaj odkritih že več kot 12.000 podzemnih jam. Od pokončnih do vodoravnih, od suhih do potopljenih, s kapniki ali brez, v njih pa, za tako ekstremno okolje, zavidljivo število različnih jamskih živali. Okoli petina površine je visokogorje. To so najvišji predeli gora, kjer podnebne razmere onemogočajo rast gozdov, in kjer preživijo le posebej prilagojene gorske rastline ter živali. Za povrhu je Slovenija na stičišču štirih velikih evropskih regij; alpske, panonske, dinarske in sredozemske. Vse našete so naravni dejavniki, zaradi katerih je Slovenija bogata dežela s pestro biotsko raznovrstnostjo. Obiskovalce iz vseh držav Evrope pa še posebej presune, da je vsa ta pestrost v tako majhni državi, da lahko v enem dnevu obiščejo visokogorje, se sprehodijo skozi dinarske pragoz-



dove, se prepustijo opoju eteričnih vonjav sredozemskih travnikov in se še pred večerom potopijo med ribe v Jadranskem morju.

Od vseh ekosistemov velja visokogorje za najbolj odmaknjenega od civilizacije – kot je v Evropi to sploh še mogoče. Zato je visokogorje na prvi pogled varno pred spremembami, ki jih človek povzroča naravi. A vendar ni tako. Potrebe turizma in

rekreacije se tudi tu stopnjujejo in vedno bolj izpodrivajo domorodne rastline in živali. Visokogorje je, kljub temu, da tu ni stalnih naselbin in tovarn, pod močnim pritiskom daljinskih vplivov, ki pridejo z vetrovi iz industrializiranih in prometnih dolin. Spremembe morda res niso tako intenzivne kot v nižinah, a za občutljive gorske živali in rastline je že malo lahko preveč. Ne pozabimo, življenje v visokogorju je podobno zahtevno kot življenje v polarnem pasu. Za hranjenje in razmnoževanje je organizmom na razpolago le poletje. V preostalih letnih časih preživijo od tega, kar so nabrali poleti. Še tako majhna sprememba, ki jo v okolju naredi človek, jim hitro spremeni ustaljen način življenja. Posledica tega je, da bodo poleti nabrali premalo za preostanek leta, pozimi pa bodo porabili preveč, nakopičenih zalog pa do naslednjega poletja ne bo dovolj. Zato spoštljivo do stalnih prebivalcev visokogorja, ko se jim povabimo v goste.



Slovenia is a land of forests, which cover more than half of its territory. We have avoided using major cutting as a means of management in a large part of the forests so there are many wild forest animals living here. The agricultural landscape of Slovenia is intensively processed. But not everywhere, thus in spring we can be amazed by meadows covered with a wide variety of colourful flowers, where insects are buzzing and jumping until the first mowing. More than half of Slovenia's territory lies on karst ground, where more than 12,000 underground caves have been discovered so far. From vertical to horizontal, dry or under water, with or without stalactites. This extreme environment also has an enviable number of different cave animals. Around one fifth of Slovenia's surface is covered by high mountains. These are the highest parts of the mountain world where climate conditions prevent forests from growing and where only specially adapted mountain plants and animals live. Slovenia is also located at the crossroad of four large European regions: Alpine, Pannon-



ian, Dinaric and Mediterranean. All of the above present natural factors that impact Slovenia's rich biodiversity. Visitors from all over Europe are especially astounded by the fact that Slovenia is such a small country, where they can visit the high mountain area, walk through dinaric forests, enjoy the scent of Mediterranean meadows and before nightfall dive among the fish in the Adriatic Sea – all this in one day.

Of all ecosystems, the high mountain area is as most remote from civilisation as can seem possible in Europe. Thus, the high mountain area seems safe from impacts caused by humans on nature. Un-

fortunately, this is not the case. The needs of tourism and recreation are increasing and affecting indigenous flora and fauna. Despite the fact that there are no permanent settlements or factories there, the high mountain area is under strong pressure caused by remote factors brought to this area by the winds from industrialised valleys burdened by traffic. The changes may not seem as intensive as in the plains area, but it can be too much for sensitive mountain animals and plants. Don't forget that life in the high mountain area is demanding in much the same way as living in the polar region. Summer is the only season when organisms can reproduce and eat. In other seasons they mostly live off what they pick in summer. Even the slightest change caused in the environment by humans can rapidly change their way of life. This causes them to gather too little food for the remaining part of the year and they use too much in winter, thus the accumulated stock will not last until the next summer. So please respect other living beings in the high mountain area when you visit. ♦

Volk je za rjavim medvedom največji predstavnik velikih zveri v Evropi. V preteklosti je poseljeval celoten evropski prostor, v 19. in 20. stoletju pa je človek volka v severnem in osrednjem delu stare celine praktično iztrebil. V zadnjih desetletjih njegova številčnost narašča in posamezne živali se po naravni poti postopoma širijo v območja, od koder so bile nekoč pregnane. Slednje velja tudi za širši alpski prostor, vključno s Triglavskim narodnim parkom. Tako kot medved se tudi volk človeka izogiba.

After the brown bear, the wolf is the second largest member of the carnivore order in Europe. It inhabited the entire European territory in the past, but in the 19th and 20th centuries, man practically exterminated the wolf in the northern and central parts of the old continent. In recent decades, its population has increased and individual animals are naturally expanding to areas from where they were once chased away. This also applies for the wider alpine area, including Triglav National Park. Like the brown bear, the wolf also avoids people. •

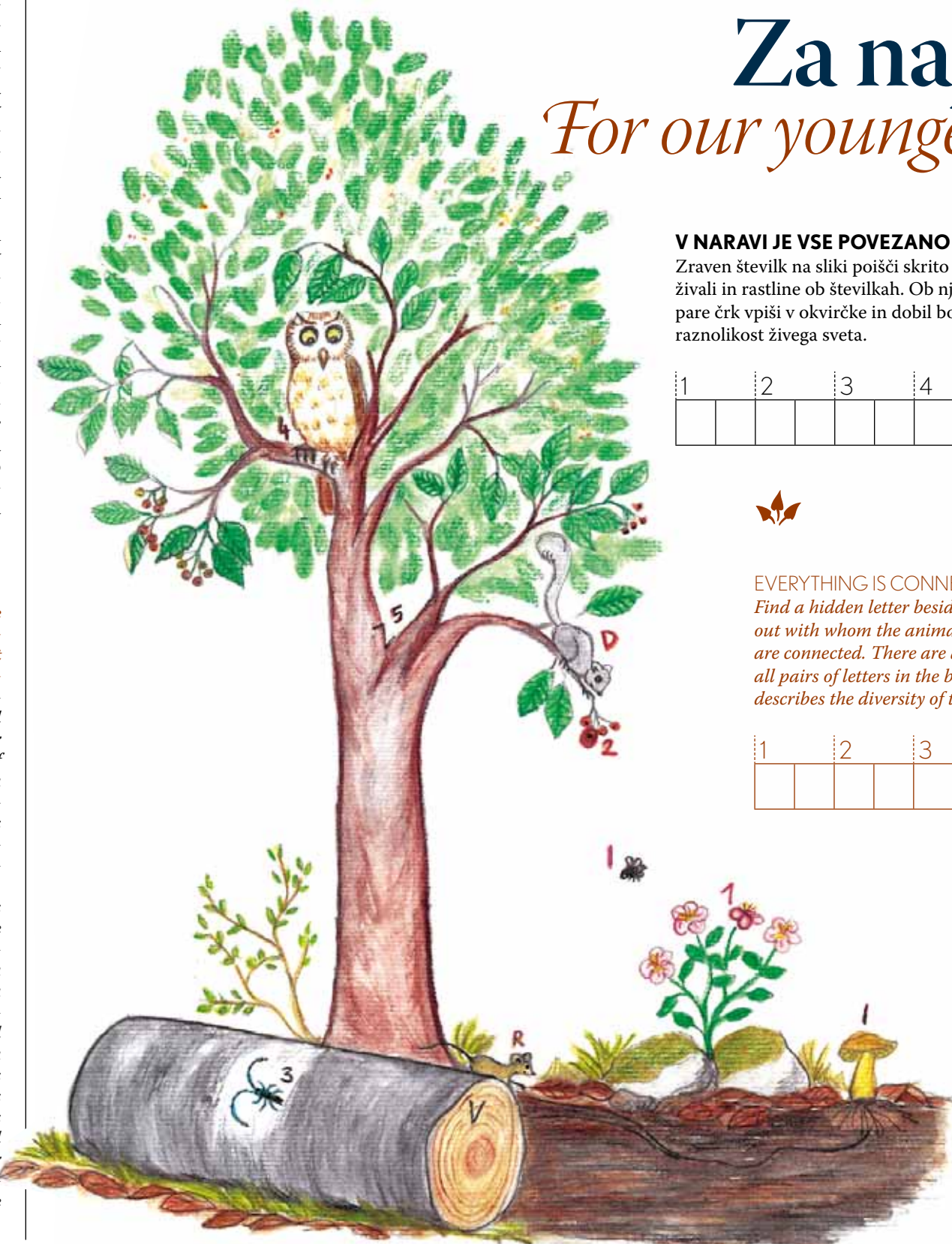

Julian Alps Biosphere Reserve



Narodni parki upravičeno spadajo med najbolj privlačna območja za obiskovalce, tako tudi Triglavski narodni park. Izjemnost območja, evropska pomembnost z vidika ohranjanja narave in kulturne dediščine ter pomen zavarovanega območja za znanstvene, kulturne, estetske in rekreacijske namene pa so bili opaženi tudi širše. Med najbolj prestižnimi priznanji območju Julijskih Alp je priznanje Organizacije ZN za izobraževanje, raziskovanje in kulturo – UNESCO, katere medvladni raziskovalni program Človek in biosfera je leta 2003 Julijske Alpe razglasil za prvo biosferno območje v Sloveniji. Gre za medvladni raziskovalni program, ki vzpostavlja svetovno mrežo biosfernih območij, kjer se ohranja ravnotežje med ljudmi in naravo, med biotsko pestrostjo in trajnostnim razvojem z ohranjanjem kulturnih vrednot. Za obiskovalce je biosferno območje Julijske Alpe eno izmed najbolj priljubljenih v Sloveniji.

National parks are top visitor destinations, and Triglav National Park is no exception. The area's outstanding features, its natural and cultural heritage of European importance, as well as the park's importance for scientific, cultural, aesthetic and recreational purposes soon caught the attention of the international community. One of the most prestigious awards received by the Julian Alps was UNESCO's Man and Biosphere in 2003, which proclaimed the Julian Alps as the first biosphere reserve in Slovenia. It is an intergovernmental research programme that aims to establish a global network of biosphere reserves which strive to uphold the balance between people and nature, biodiversity and sustainable development, and upkeep of cultural values. In terms of visitation, the Julian Alps Biosphere Reserve ranks among the most popular destinations in Slovenia. •

Pot miru povezuje dediščino 1.

svetovne vojne, naravne znamenitosti, kraje in ljudi vse od Triglavskega narodnega parka do Jadranskega morja. Umirja ritem časa in vabi k oddihu ali razmisleku – več kot 100 let po soški fronti in njenih bitkah ob Soči in na Krasu.

V muzeju na prostem Kolovrat je moč raziskati nekdanjo italijansko obrambno črto s še danes ohranjenimi poveljniškimi mesti, strelskimi položaji, mrežo jarkov in kavern. Kolovrat je bil za Italijane ena ključnih obrambnih točk v 12. soški bitki, ki je pri Kobaridu pred stotimi leti preobrnila potek soške fronte. This is one of the most popular and easily accessible sites along the Walk of Peace from the Alps to the Adriatic. The ridge stretching from Kobarid to Goriška Brda offers exceptional views of the emerald Soča River, the Julian Alps, the Veneto region, the Friuli Lowlands

and the Adriatic Sea. It is interesting for hikers, cyclists, families and school groups. Visitors can enjoy the peace and the beauties of nature. During the First World War, Kolovrat was witness to the destructive front.

The Walk of Peace links the heritage of the First World War with natural sites, places and people of the area from Triglav National Park to the Adriatic Sea. It calms the rhythm of time and invites you to relax or think – more than 100 years after the Isonzo Front and its battles along the Soča River and in the Karst area.

The Kolovrat Outdoor Museum is a venue where you can explore the former Italian defence line and preserved command points, shooting positions, and the network of trenches and caverns. For Italians, Kolovrat was one of the key defence points during the 12th Isonzo Battle, which changed the course of the Isonzo Front near Kobarid one hundred years ago. This former line of separation is now the expression of the uniting power of memory, because while discovering history, visitors walk on the territory of the Slovenian and Italian states.

The Walk of Peace in the Soča Region Foundation offers guided tours along the Walk of Peace throughout the year. Every Friday at 10 a.m. and 12 a.m. in July and August, you can join a guided tour of the outdoor museum. •

The beautiful alpine villages Mojstrana, Dovje, Zgornja Radovna and Belca are located beneath the 2864-metre-high Triglav, the highest Slovenian mountain and the symbol of Slovenehood. They feature exceptional natural and cultural heritage, and are home to the Triglav fairy tales and to kind, but stubborn people who know how to survive in a beautiful but at the same time ruthless alpine world.

The development of mountaineering in Slovenia began in Mojstrana. At the Pri Šmercu Inn, Dr. Julius Jugy hired mountain guides who helped him climb Triglav. Here is where the German poet Rudolf Baumbach wrote the first Slovenian tale about Zlatorog. Perhaps these are all reasons why the Slovenian Alpine Museum was founded in this area. It features an interactive experience of a man who hikes in the mountains, admires the beauties of the alpine world and overcomes all dangers, before returning home full of impressions that motivate him to express his feelings in art.

Mojstrana is the starting point for entering the beautiful Vrata, Radovna, Kot and Krma alpine valleys. Walk to the valley of Vrata. The 52-metre-high Peričnik Waterfall can be found on the way towards the mighty Triglav North Face. When in Vrata, you will most certainly stop at the Aljažev dom alpine hut named after the Dovje priest and national awakener, Jakob Aljaž, who more than 120 years ago bought the

peak of Triglav and set a tower on it. The neighbouring village of Dovje is a very nice rural village where you will be greeted by the sight of domestic animals, view the village troughs, exceptionally beautiful farms, and St Michael's Church. Start your hiking tour to the Karavanke mountain range, a natural border between Slovenia and Austria, from the Pr' Katr Inn. The hikes in the Karavanke mountains are technically demanding and they provide beautiful views of the Julian Alps.

Hummocky meadows are still preserved in Zgornja Radovna. This village has the 400-year-old Gogala's linden tree, Pocar Homestead, and the Psnak mill and saw mill, while the Psnak Inn offers great things to eat. The most western village beneath Triglav, i.e. Belca, has no inn and no church, but it has the "Olympic street".

Discovering the flavours of the Prealpi Giulie Nature Park

Naravna biotska raznovrstnost Čezmejnega območja Ekoregija Julijske Alpe je prav tako prisotna v kmetovanju. Številne vrste in pasme so se ohranile navkljub negativnim vplivom industrializiranega kmetovanja in standardizacije, zato zdaj predstavljajo izjemno bogastvo, ki ga lahko opazujejo vsi obiskovalci.

Bogastvo Naravnega parka Julijsko predgorje pa spodbuja tudi projekt z naslovom »Parkovna košarica (Il Paniere del Parco)«. Projekt se je začel pred nekaj leti z namenom promocije značilnih lokalnih izdelkov in pomagati kmetom pri njihovih dnevnih trajnostnih, a težavnih dejavnostih.

Na tem območju izdelujejo in pridelujejo pet živih oziroma izdelkov, ki so značilni za posamezne občine: česen Resia, jed Il Brovadâr di Moggio Udinese, buča iz Venzone, fižol Fiorina iz Lusevera, in sir Malga Montasio. Vsa ta živila in izdelki so zelo posebni, pristni in okusni.

Če jih želite poskusiti, izberite kraj, ga obiščite in povprašajte po njih pri kmetih ali v restavracijah. Paziti pa morate na pravi čas.

Il Brovadâr di Moggio Udinese

lahko poskusite od novembra do pomladi: je tradicionalna gastronomska specialiteta, glavna sestavina jedi pa je sorta majhne, pozno posejane poljske repe. Uporablja se za značilne juhe ali kot priloga.

Na gorski kmetiji Malga Montasio, ki se nahaja ob vznožju gore Montaž in zre proti Kaninu, lahko sir poskusite od junija do septembra. Zanj so značilni tipična slamnato rumena barva, blag okus in izjemna aroma.

Julij in avgust pa sta meseca, ko lahko poskusite česen Resia. Izjemen česen rožnato rdeče barve kmetje vzgajajo le v dolini Reziji na način, ki se prenaša z generacije na generacijo. Česen je zelo znan po celi Italiji, saj je že leta 2004 prejel nagrado Slow Food Presidium.

Dve vrsti zelenjave pa sta značilni za oktober: buča Venzone in fižol Lusevera Fiorina. Buča je zelo priljubljena in se uporablja v jedeh, značilnih za Venzone, še zlasti na letnem tradicionalnem festivalu buč Festa della Zucca. Fižol je dobil ime po gospe, ki je izbrala in ohranila to sorto fižola. Prav tako se uporablja kot sestavina za jed *stak* (pretlačen fižol s krompirjem in slanino).

Vsi, ki bi želeli okusiti vse te jedi, to lahko storite na kmetijskem sej-

mu Festa dell' agricoltura v Resiutti. Vsako prvo nedeljo v oktobru so na tem sejmu na voljo vsi navedeni izdelki ter druge posebne in zanimive jedi s tega območja. Medtem pa se lahko pogovorite s proizvajalci o pridelavi in pripravi teh avtentičnih naravnih in kulinarčnih zakladov.



In all the Transboundary Ecoregion Julian Alps nature biodiversity has also produced biodiversity in farming. Several species and breeds had been preserved by the negative impacts of industrialised farming and standardisation and are now an extraordinary treasure available to those coming to visit the area.

This richness of Prealpi Giulie Nature Park area is enhanced through a specific project named "The Park basket (Il Paniere del Parco)". It started some years ago with the goal to promote a few local typical products and to help farmers in their everyday sustainable but difficult activities.

There are five highlights of the area, one in each Municipality: Resia Garlic, Brovadâr of Moggio Udinese, Pumpkin in Venzone, Fiorina Bean of Lusevera, and Malga Montasio Cheese. Some are vegetables, some others processed food products, but all of them are very special: genuine and tasty.

If you want to discover them just select the place, go there and ask the farmers or in the restaurants. However, be careful to choose the right time.

From November to springtime you can taste Brovadâr in Moggio Udinese: it's a traditional gastronomic preparation, the main ingredient is a variety of small, late-sown field turnip. Used for typical soups or as side dish.

Malga (Mountain farm) Montasio, located at the feet of Mount Montasio and facing Mount Canin, is ready to offer from June to September its typical cheese. It is characterized by a straw yellow colour and mild and tasty flavour.



July and August are the months of Resia Garlic. A real special pink – reddish garlic cultivated only in Resia Valley and preserved by local people from generation to generation. It's very famous all over Italy because it has been named Slow Food Presidium since 2004.

Two are the October products: Venzone Pumpkin and Lusevera Fiorina Bean. The first dominates the scene and is widely used in dishes served every year in Venzone, especially during the traditional "Festa della Zucca (Pumpkin Festival)". The latter got its name from a lady who selected and preserved the bean. It's also used as ingredient for the "Stak" (a typical puree made from beans, potatoes and lard).

For those who want to experience all of them there's a great opportunity at the "Festa dell'agricoltura (Agriculture feast)" in Resiutta. There, the first Sunday in October, you can find all these products and several special other from the area. While having an interesting talk with the producers who day after day preserve the wise knowledge of the cultivation and preparation of these authentic natural and culinary treasures.

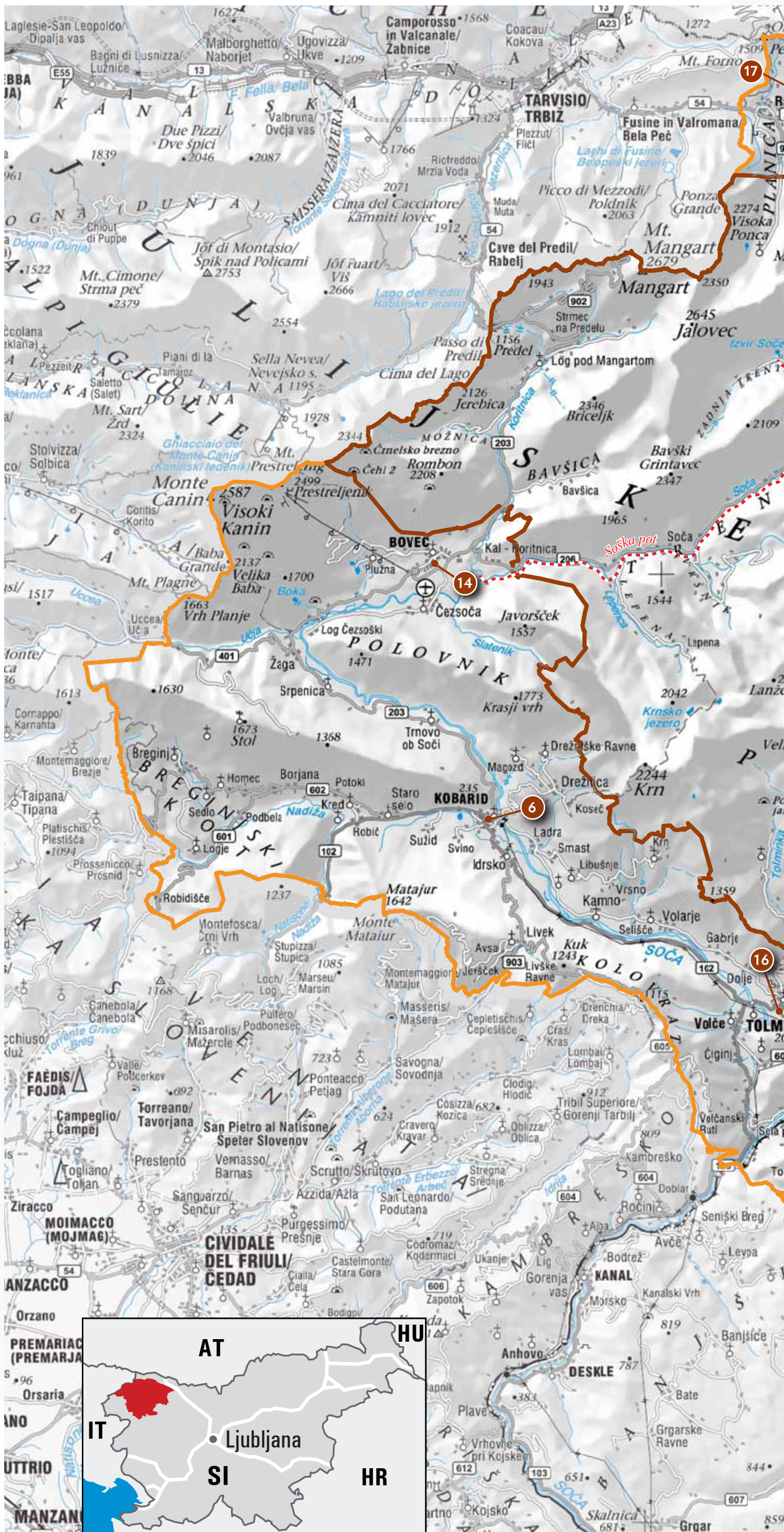

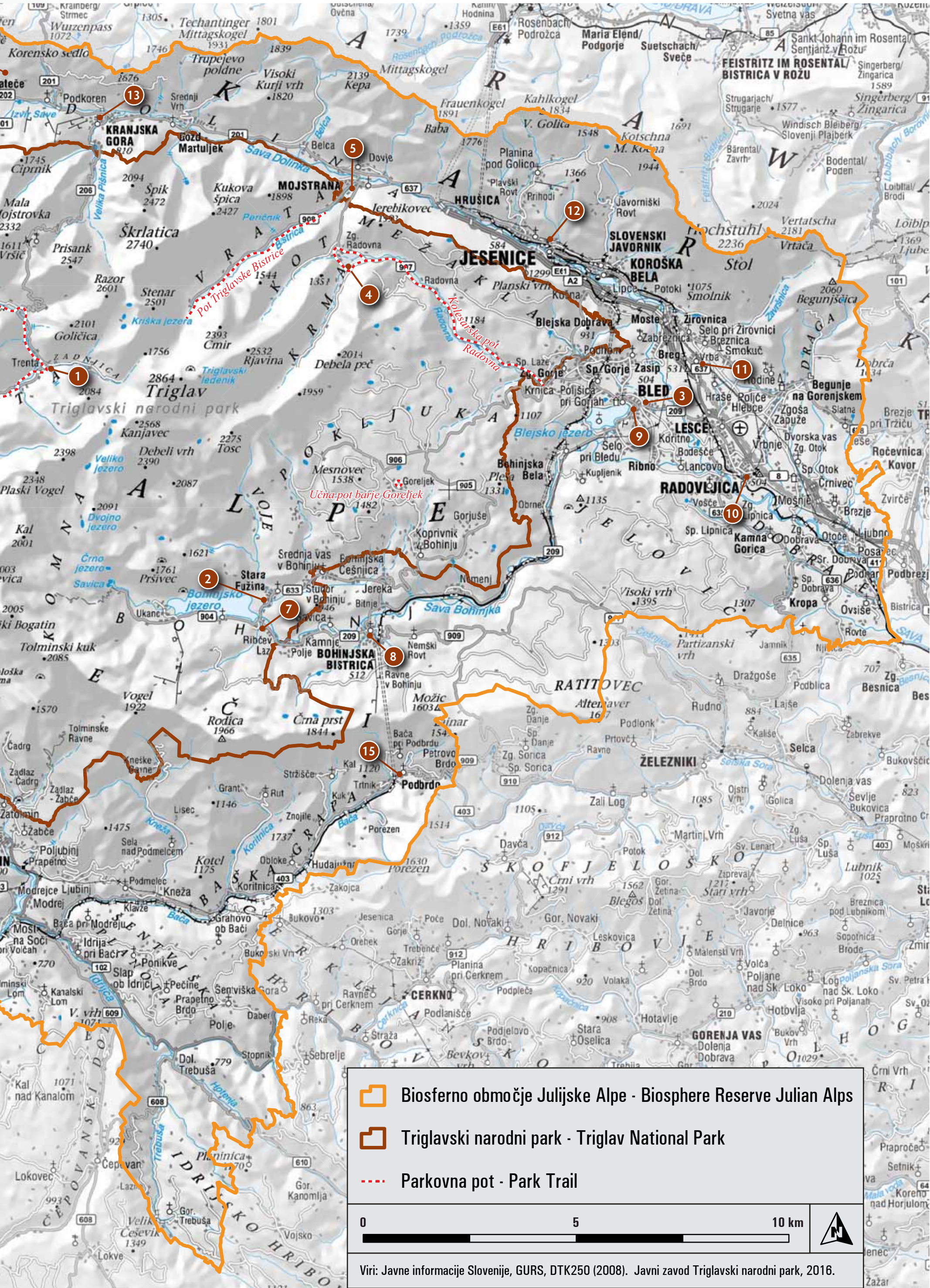

The panoramic and historical Bohinj Railway Line between Jesenice and Nova Gorica enables visitors to experience two different worlds – the Alpine and the Submediterranean. A special feature of this railway line is that your car can be loaded onto the train for a section of the route. The car train between Bohinjska Bistrica and Nova Gorica is the most comfortable option of traversing both regions. PLOVNI REŽIM V OBČINI BOHINJ:

Na Bohinjskem jezeru je dovoljena plovba vse leto s plovili dolžine do 8 m. Plovba v območju kopalnih voda na Bohinjskem jezeru, ki merijo 100 m od obale, ni dovoljena, razen v primeru plovbe iz/do vstopno-izstopnih mest ali pristanišč. Na Savi Bohinjki je plovba dovoljena za športne veslaške čolne do dolžine 8 m in sicer od 1. aprila do 31. oktobra; v aprilu in oktobru med 10. in 17. uro, v maju in septembru med 10. in 18. uro ter v juniju, juliju in avgustu med 9. in 19. uro. Vstop na Bohinjsko jezero in Savo Bohinjko je dovoljen samo na vstopno-izstopnih mestih in pristaniščih. Za uporabo vstopno-izstopnih mest in privezov v pristaniščih je potrebno kupiti dovolilnico. Dovolilnica mora biti nalepljena na plovilo in ni prenosljiva. Dovolilnice so na voljo v TIC-ih in pri nekaterih ponudnikih športnih aktivnosti na vodi. THE NAVIGATION REGIME IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BOHINJ:

Navigation by vessel up to a maximum 8m in length is permitted on Lake Bohinj all year round. Navigation in the Lake Bohinj bathing area, which stretches 100m from the shore, is not permitted, except for navigation to/from the entry/exit points or moorings. Navigation on the Sava Bohinjka River is permitted for sport rowing boats from 1 April to 31 October, in April from 10 am to 5 pm, in May and September from 10 am to 6 pm, and in June, July and August from 9 am to 7 pm. Entry to Lake Bohinj and the Sava Bohinjka River is permitted only at the defined entry-exit points and at moorings. In order to use these entry-exit points and moorings you need to purchase a permit. The permit must be glued to the vessel and is not transferable. Permits are available from the Bohinj Tourist Information Centre and selected providers of water sports activities. Information: Turizem Bohinj (Bohinj Tourist Board), +386 (0)4 57 47 590.

Ko zavihamo rokave za lastne ideje, se spet najdejo takšni, ki nas učijo drugače ... Razlika je samo

v tem, ali tu živiš, delaš in spiš 365 dni v letu, ali si le občasni obiskovalec ob lepem vremenu, ali podjetnik, ki žanje letni dobiček v juliju in avgustu, ali uradnik v eni od pisarn iz središča Slovenije.

Ko se spomladi budi življenje in s snežišč v dolino bučijo številni slapovi, poleti, ko pokošena diši in kot mladenka vabi številne v goste in v dolini mrgoli ljudi, jeseni, ko se s planin vrača drobnica in deževje naznaja počitek, pozimi, ko se narava umiri in snujemo nove načrte, so pristni trenutki, ki jih doživljamo domačini.

V primerjavi s preteklostjo nas danes na domačih tleh vztraja le peščica. Malo, a še vedno dovolj, da lahko sami ali v sodelovanju z drugimi izvedemo vse zastavljene cilje. Pri tem nas vedno navdihuje in vzbuja spoštovanje spomin na pretekle rodove, ki so v skromnih razmerah in z lastnim znanjem ohranili življenje v dolini. Včasih razmišljam in se sprašujem, kaj ima Triglavski narodni park od nas in mi od njega? Vprašanje je morda kot o kuri in jajcu. Zagotovo pa lahko zmagamo z obojestranskim sodelovanjem in zdravo pametjo.



This is a picturesque valley in Triglav National Park, surrounded by more than fifteen mountains over two thousand metres high.

Mangrt, Jalovec, Loška stena and Bricelj, Veliki vrh (Rombon) and Jerebica are the main peaks surrounding the valley.

Many find it remote and hidden, but it is always lit by sun rays and accessible all over the year. The area takes every visitor's breath away. Those who diligently plan their tour are enthused, and those who come here by chance are overwhelmed by the power and beauty of the valley. Time and time again, locals feel happiness, joy and pride whenever coming back home over the Predel pass and seeing Mangrt and Jalovec in the beautiful sunset.

As the centre of the valley, Log pod Mangrtom and its surroundings have a rich history as well as many natural and cultural features. Some people might even envy us, others say that the locals do not know how to exploit this, and some use it without us even knowing ... When we try to bring our own ideas to life, some people want to teach us otherwise ... It differs depending on whether you live, work and sleep here 365 days a year or you are just

an occasional visitor in nice weather, or an entrepreneur profiting in July and August, or just an official sitting in an office in the centre of Slovenia.

When life awakens in spring and when waterfalls storm to the valley from snowy areas, in summer when the grass is cut and when the valley invites guests for a visit and when there are many people there, and in autumn when the cattle return from the pastures, or in winter when nature settles down and when we make new plans, these are the genuine moments experienced by the local people.

Compared to the past, only a handful of us still persist in living on this land. A few but still enough to implement all the set goals by ourselves or in cooperation with others. We are always inspired and motivated by the respect and the memory of past generations who have preserved life in the valley in modest conditions and with their own knowledge. Sometimes I think about this and wonder what we offer to Triglav National Park and vice versa? This is a bit like the question about the chicken and the egg. But we can certainly win with mutual cooperation and common sense. •
